

How to make the best use of ChatGPT for coding

I am not particularly good in making a program in Python from the start. As there is a huge library of Python software, I usually take an existing code and then try to adapt it. Also, in the end, ChatGPT suggests additional options to make the results more interesting. As with social media, I must limit the offerings to the essentials otherwise I will spend endless hours on non-essential activities.
